Once the client contractually commits to the delivery of the course and DBIA's provision of the facility and/or equipment, the client is responsible for any costs incurred by DBIA associated with facilities and/or equipment, including the general and administrative overhead fee, as applicable, in the event of a cancellation by the client within 30 days of the scheduled course delivery.
