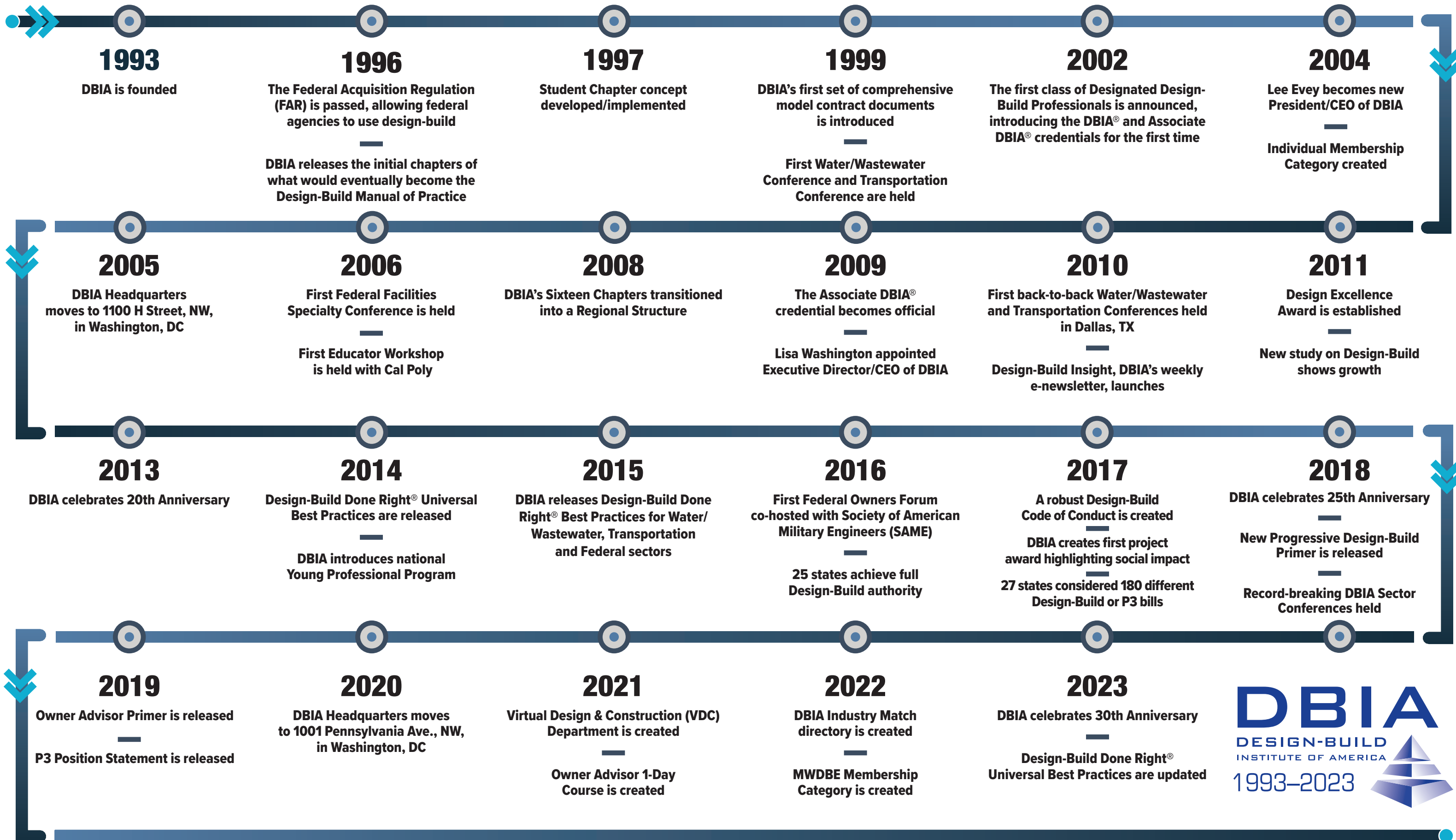


# DBIA MAJOR MILESTONES OVER 30 YEARS

**1996**

The Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) is passed, allowing federal agencies to use design-build

DBIA releases the initial chapters of what would eventually become the Design-Build Manual of Practice

**1997**

Student Chapter concept developed/implemented

**1999**

DBIA's first set of comprehensive model contract documents is introduced

First Water/Wastewater Conference and Transportation Conference are held

**2002**

The first class of Designated Design-Build Professionals is announced, introducing the DBIA® and Associate DBIA® credentials for the first time

**2004**

Lee Evey becomes new President/CEO of DBIA
