



Brunelleschi Lifetime Achievement Award 2023 Nomination Requirements

The Brunelleschi Lifetime Achievement Award is the highest individual honor DBIA bestows. It is presented to individuals who have made significant contributions to the design and construction industry through outstanding leadership and innovation in the advancement of design-build project delivery. Recipients of this award have exhibited originality, vision, and breadth over the course of their professional life, with **30 years or more** of strong and well-documented commitment to design-build project delivery. Nominations are due no later than **July 18, 2023**. Submitters will be notified of the applicant's status by **mid-August**.

- In **300 words or less**, provide an overview of the nominee's career that describes the relevance of the nominee's professional career to the advancement of successful design-build, including the earliest demonstration (year) of this commitment.
- Provide **up to five (5) examples** of service and/or work product over nominee's career that have contributed to either the advancement of design-build and/or the application of Design-Build Done Right® principles and practices. Each should be **150 words or less**.
- List **up to five (5) noteworthy** design-build projects in which the nominee has been involved, including the nominee's role on project team, any awards won for the project, and any notable achievements on the project.
